UPDATES FOR 2025

Not much is changing in 2025 – we're focusing on learning the ropes and keeping a good thing going. That being said, we're implementing a few tweaks based on feedback from last year:

- Minimum requirements for cup eligibility in order to ensure that all fields are competitive, a racer must fulfill the following criteria in order to win:
 - Participate in 50% or more of the Cup calendar
 - Defeat at least two other riders in their category
- Category updates we will be tweaking the age ranges for Junior and Masters categories based on participation rates from the past several years. The new categories are outlined on the next page.
- Live updates on social media we will be capturing photos and videos at Cup events, interviewing racers, and posting live results on the ICA social media accounts (1,900+ combined followers)
- Applications are due by March 17, 2025 visit www.illinoiscup.org to submit your bid.

CUP REQUIREMENTS

All Illinois Cup events **must be permitted through USA Cycling** and meet the minimum required length.

All rules in the USA Cycling road rulebook must be enforced.

Each required category must be offered at an Illinois Cup race. **Cup categories may be combined** (e.g. running multiple Junior fields simultaneously) but must be scored separately.

Logos for USA Cycling, the Illinois Cycling Association, and the Illinois Cup must be included on all promotional materials. Website logos should also link to the USAC (www.usacycling.org), ICA (www.illinoiscycling.org), and Illinois Cup (www.illinoiscup.org) websites, respectively.

Promoters should clearly denote on all printed and electronic materials which race categories are part of the Illinois Cup.

Photo finish equipment is required. If BikeReg is used as the registration platform, the ICA can supply a finish line camera and other associated equipment.

2025 CUP CATEGORIES

While we'd like to adhere to these categories as closely as possible, we are willing to work with you based on the specific needs of your event.

- Elite Men and Elite Women
 - Category 1/2
 - Category 3
 - Category 4
- Masters Men* and Masters Women*
 - Age 40-49
 - Age 50-59
 - Age 60+
- Junior Boys and Junior Girls
 - Age 9-12
 - Age 13-14
 - Age 15-18

*Masters Cat 4/5 will be scored separately for the Illinois Cup but does not need to be a separate field.

AWARD REQUIREMENTS

The winner of each Illinois Cup category will receive a free entry into each Cup race the following year. This award is non-transferable and good for one entry per race. For this offer to be valid, the rider must pre-register.

Applications for the 2025 Illinois Cup may be submitted at **www.illinoiscup.org** and are due by **March 14, 2025**. Please have the following information on hand:
